

# PHOTOGRAPHY

## CHECKLIST



This is a general packing list with recommendations in terms of photography equipment for an expedition. Every trip is unique with special considerations - please bear that in mind.

## PHOTOGRAPHY ESSENTIALS

- Camera(s) - charger - battery & manual
- Normal zoom lens (Landscape to portrait - focal length with large sensor ~ 24-70 mm)
- Wide angle zoom lens (Capture the grand landscape - focal length with large sensor ~ 16-35 mm)
- Telezoom lens (Photograph animals and nature - focal length with large sensor ~ 100-400 mm)
- Memory cards - take many of them
- Computer - laptop, iPad or other device for downloading and looking at pictures during the trip
- Transfer pictures - memory card reader, cables

## CHECKLIST



### RECOMMENDED

- Macro lens - close up pictures (focal length with large sensor ~ 100-180 mm)
- Filters - polarizing-, gradient-, ND filters and possibly diopters
- Adapter - always check to see what kind of sockets are available
- External hard drive - always take plenty of storage with you
- Extra camera - if an accident happens to your primary camera, or if one is in the uw-housing
- Tripod - for landscape, tele and video shots
- Action camera with accessories
- Tele converter - x1.4 or 1.7
- Maintenance - cloths for polishing, cleaning fluids, bellows etc.

### TIPS

- Camera & Lenses - are safest packed in the hand baggage.
- Camera bag - a good way to be able to take several more kilos on the plane.
- Extra camera battery - long days of photography are possible without having to stop to recharge.
- Power cord - turn one socket into three or four.
- Manuals - download them in digital form and have them with you.
